A SAFE BET FOR YOUR PROTECTION.

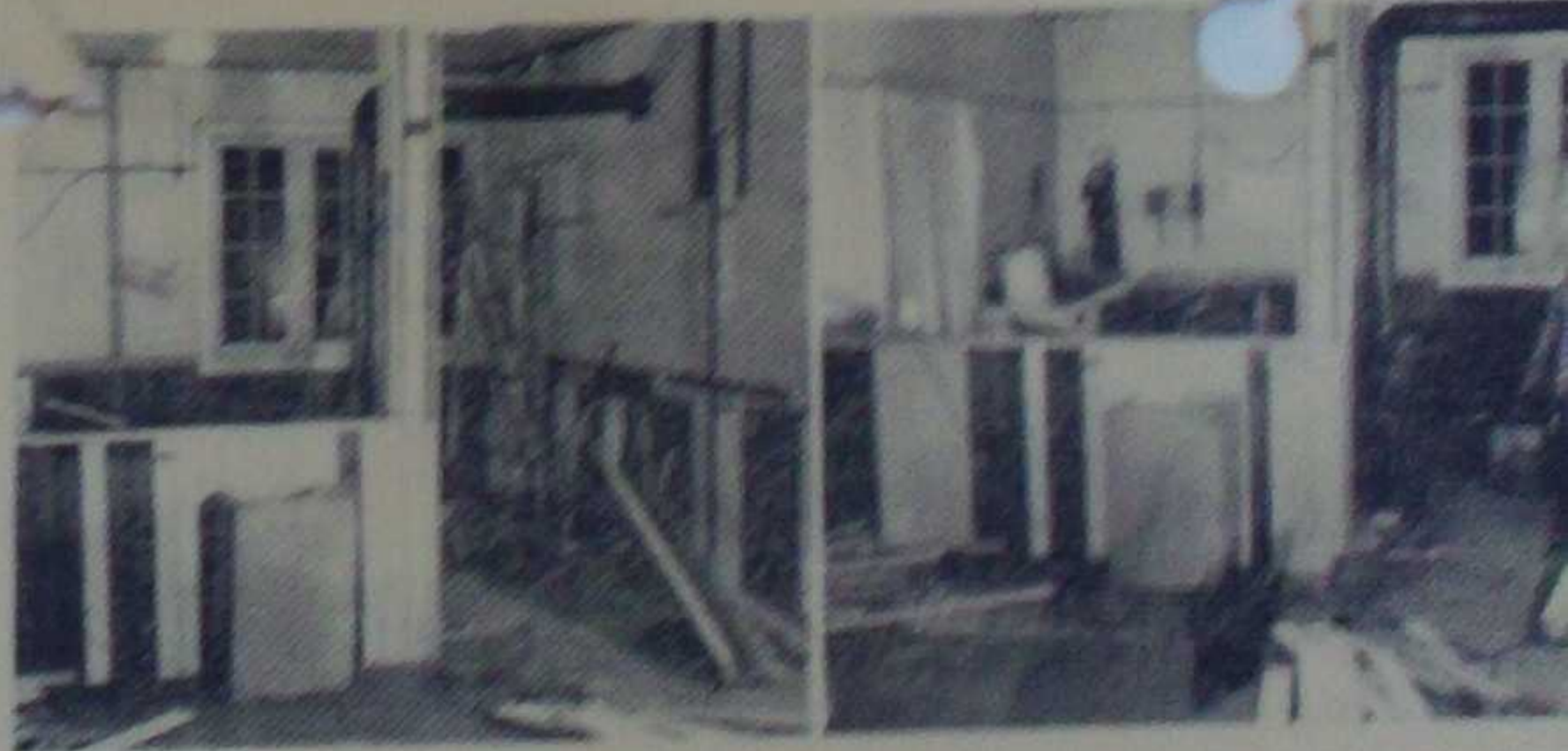
## DRY ROT BOTHERING YOU?

Three simple rules will take care of this problem.

1. Check for rot in the FALL—take out all dubious wood.
2. Soak or coat all adjacent wood with bichloride of mercury.
3. In the SPRING replace rotten parts taken out in the Fall—use Cuprinol on all new work and on any non protected surface (when taking hull down to bare wood Cuprinol before varnishing or painting).
