Treasurer's Report

WINTARIO MAY VISIT QUEEN CITY

Before Christmas the International 14 fleet at Queen City got together and decided to do something about the lagging interest in small boat sailing.

Generally, it was felt that it is difficult to attract racing dinghy sailors into a club where class fleets are wanting. A good active group will always pick up the best new sailors, i.e. Royals and T.S.C.C. Our club desperately needs dinghy sailors, people who race dinghies not because of low initial cost while they save for big boats, but people who genuinely enjoy the physical and mental challenge of teamwork in a wet, tippy boat.

We felt the biggest loss the club suffers in this area is the failure to provide an organized, continuing challenge in sailing for youths who have graduated from the Junior Club. With this in mind, we made the following presentation for junior club expansion to Wintario. To date we have received a provisional commitment, which means we merely have to furnish proof of financing for two-thirds of the project. In our case, this means showing cancelled cheques for the six Albacores purchased in 1975.
