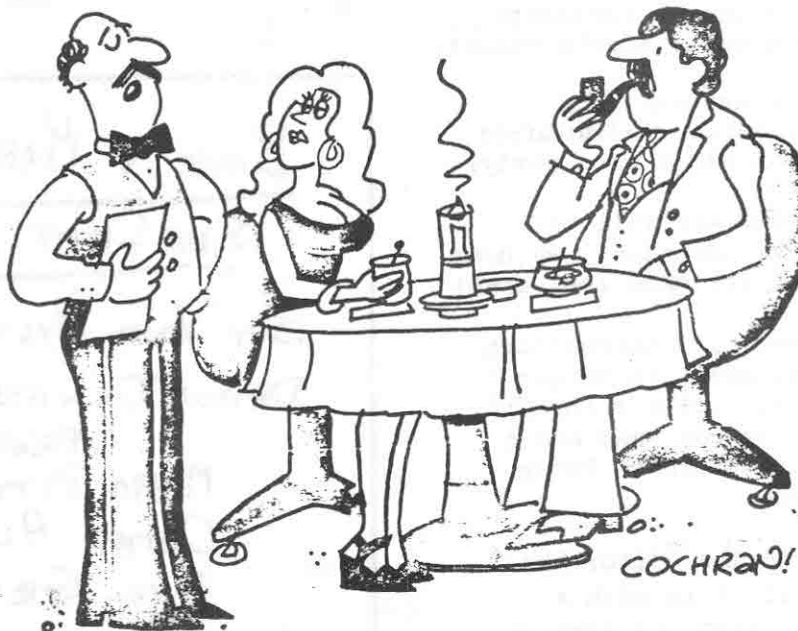
(Ed's. Note: Our sincere apologies to Peter and Moya. It seems our July investigative reporter didn't investigate far enough!)

Our fountain once graced the front lawn of the home of Mrs. de Haas. This was a lovely home on the Lakeshore, with a beautiful garden. The CBC wanted the fountain for a prop and offered a good price for it. However, Mrs. de Haas insisted that it be given to QCYC, where her daughter, Ginny, was a Junior Club instructor, having passed through the Junior Club. Her son, Kenny, was to follow as an instructor a few years later.

The fountain was dismantled and brought to the club in sections in a wheelbarrow. The gang got to work with wire brushes in an effort to remove about 16 coats of paint. This was found to be too great a job, so it was taken to the city and sandblasted. Many features were revealed which had been obscured by paint. When it was installed, Al Rae got a special nozzle for the top which would shoot the water 15 feet in the air.

Our fountain, which has operated off and on ever since, is once again working this year.
