- Clean fuel tank vent

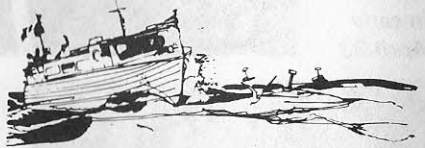
It was also helpful having the boat in the water to transfer staff and equipment to the club, prior to opening, thus getting the season off to an early start.
