

YACHT RACING IN TORONTO.

TORONTO, Ontario, July 17.—The third day's races of the Lake Yacht Racing Association circuit came off here to-day, under the auspices of the Queen City Yacht Club. In the forty-foot class the Yama of Oswego beat the White Wings of Hamilton by 1 minute and 38 seconds, in addition to 8:30 time allowance. In the thirty-five-foot class the Dinah of Hamilton won, defeating the Alert of Hamilton by 26 minutes. The thirty-foot class race was won by the Euna of Toronto, with the Lotus of Hamilton second, the Velnette of Rochester finishing fourth. The Maud B. of Hamilton won the twenty-five-foot class race, with the Hilda of Toronto second. In the twenty-one-foot class race the Kathleen of Toronto finished first, with the Elsie of Toronto second.
