TORONTO WILL COLLECT BILLS. Suit Against York Township—Other Municipalities Owe Accounts Also.

"In every case where patients are sent to Toronto by outside municipalities I intend to see that they pay the expense for medical attendance and keep," said Dr. Sheard, the Medical Health Officer, in his references to the tendency on the part of outside municipalities to take advantage of Toronto's facilities for treating contagious diseases.

"Outside municipalities are so penurious that they cannot possibly take proper care of their sick," said Dr. Sheard. "In most cases the medical health officers are not paid more than \$100 a year. They have very little hospital accommodation, and rather than spend money on the necessary equipment they prefer to send their patients to Toronto."
